In the field of foreign policy: State visits by the head of our state raised the international authority of Uzbekistan to a new level.

Shavkat Mirziyoyev’s speech at the 72nd session of the UN General Assembly on September 20, 2017 is also historical, in which he noted that the method of fighting terrorism using force is not justified, and that the most important task is to educate and educate people. , first of all, the thinking of young people based on education. Shavkat Mirziyoyev, a meeting of Arab-Muslim countries and the United States was held in the city of Riyadh. As a result of negotiations between the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Islamic Development Bank, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed. Another important aspect of the year was the adoption of the resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan “On organizing the activities of the Public Council on the Contemporary History of Uzbekistan at the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan.” Today it is known that in the era of information inequality observed in the global media field, conflicts between international media monopolies, constant information attacks between competing countries and regions, contradictions and ideological conflicts are growing, and political and economic relations are worsening. becoming more complex, it is no longer difficult to notice cases of intentional damage to the image. In the Presidential Decree of January 28, 2022 “On the development strategy of New Uzbekistan for 2022-2026”, special

attention is paid to the issue of increasing the efficiency of information support aimed at improving the image of our country in the world. communities along with systematic reform of the media sector. The document defines a number of important goals and objectives in accordance with the state program for implementing the development strategy of New Uzbekistan for 2022-2026 in the “year of human dignity and active neighborhood.”

In recent years, in accordance with the process of large-scale democratic reforms and the globalization of information, significant work has been done to create a perfect image of the new Uzbekistan, a new media image.
