Military discipline is to be faithful to the military oath from a military servant, to strictly obey the laws and constitutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan; to fulfill their duty skillfully and courageously; to study military work honestly; preservation of military and state property; to courageously overcome the difficulties of military service, and not to spare their lives to fulfill their military duty; to be generous, to keep strict western and state secrets; to support the relationship between military personnel referred to in the military, to strengthen the brotherhood of war; to show dignity to the commanders and to each other, and to follow the rules of military peace and courtesy; It requires behaving appropriately in public places, restraining himself and others from unscrupulous behavior, and protecting the reputation and reputation of citizens.

Such a load strengthens the confidence of military personnel in themselves, as well as awakens their desire to solve more complex issues;

If a military serviceman is struggling in a developed combat situation, he is invited to solve lighter tasks. Factors that affect the spirituality of a military officer (danger, emergency, uncertainty, innovation, increased mobility, time shortages...) they are divided into two groups: primary and secondary factors.

Risks are recognized as the primary factor. Secondary factors include emergency, uncertainty, innovation, and so on. Psychological modelling of a battle is divided into the following components: motivational component, cognitive components, and motor components. Such separation is conditional, and it is necessary to intelligently plan psychological models and make tahlil.

Motivation component: motivations encourage a person to function. We model the motivation component by activating motivations in training sessions. There are three types of motives:

1. Motivations of broad social importance are love for God, duty, loyalty to the people, hatred of enemies;
2. Jamoatchilik motivlari – jamoatchilik hissi, o'z bo'linmasi uchun faxrlanish;
3. Personal motivations are the desire to get the attention of others, the strengthening or change of position, the commander's praise.

Motivations differ depending on the impact on efficiency of activities. First-team motivations have a positive effect on performance, while second and third group motivations can have both positive and negative effects.

It turned out that military personnel first and foremost needed to activate the motives of the first group. At the same time, it is necessary to make the most of the motives of the second and third groups. Creating a k-hit situation between motivations in the congregation is a major educational

one. For example, greater progress can be made by subjugation of personal interests to the interests of the community, creating dangerous situations. These works are also necessary to nurture the will. Because the struggle of motives is one of the conditions for shaping will. The effectiveness and direction of the activity depends on the choice of his motivation. Modeling a motivation component is one of the most difficult processes in psychological preparation.

The component in the knowledge narrow. The proper assessment of the situation by military personnel will depend on the perception that takes place on the basis of their cognitive entities.

We do not reflect in our minds all the influences that are on our spirituality. The level of reflection in our minds of the external committee depends on how important it is for our life's activities. The intuition occurs between its lower and upper boundaries. If the causative sensation is affected around the lower and upper limits, it becomes difficult to properly perceive the effect. In combat conditions, there will be a lot of stimulants forming movements around the boundaries of such perception. It is desirable to learn how to properly understand such changes in the educational process.

By creating a model of components characterized by knowledge, military personnel are enriched by perceptions of a real battle. This means that one of the most important problems of psychological preparation has been solved.

Action component. In carrying out any activity or its separate actions, the soldier performs a separate set of operations. The complex of such operations is diverse for various military specialties. The creation of a motor component prohibits all or most of the necessary operations in the context of real combat activity from being performed by a soldier.

In conclusion, it is important in all respects to prepare employees spiritually for military discipline in combat situations. It is necessary to take into account the age and psychological aspects of a bundle of military personnel.

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
