In most developed countries, state programs on citizens' patriotism education, concepts of increasing the effectiveness of military patriotism education have been adopted, and many community-based veterans and public organizations have been established that are engaged in the patriotism education of young people and receive financial support from the state. At the initiative of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Shavkat Mirziyoyev, a new stage of reforms has been launched in the field of state policy in the military sphere, increasing the defense potential of the Armed Forces. In addition, the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan named the cadet schools that provide military education to young people in our country as "Temurbek School", awarded the State Award "Brave Boys" to young men who have achieved great results in various fields and sectors, and implemented the state policy on youth, study, work, public they also offered to establish the "Builder of the Future" medal in order to reward our young men and women who are actively involved in their work. The "Builder of the Future" medal was established in order to reward young men and women who are actively involved in education, work, and public affairs.

Also, the military organization of the state is a set of state administration and military administration bodies, the Armed Forces, other bodies, institutions and special structures created for wartime, as well as the defense industry complex, whose joint activities are aimed at solving the tasks of ensuring military security;

**National defense** - a system of political, economic, military, socio-legal, informational, organizational and other types of measures that ensure the sovereignty, territorial integrity, peaceful life and security of the population of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

**Threatening period** - a period of time that lasts for a different period of time, as a rule, before the beginning of a military conflict and is characterized by an extremely tense military-political situation;

**Emergency situation** - an accident, disaster, dangerous natural phenomenon, natural or other disaster in a certain area that can cause or has caused people to become victims, damage to their health or the environment, cause serious material losses, and disrupt people's living conditions the situation that occurred;

**Armed Conflict** - conflict between states (international armed conflict) or within the territory of one state (internal armed conflict)

**A limited-scale armed conflict** for the purpose of conflict resolution is an economic, political, national, ethnic, religious and other (movement, conflict) between the parties, in which the state of war is not declared;

**Military Conflict** is a form of resolving conflicts between states or internal states using military force, which includes all types of armed struggle, including wars and armed conflicts;

**Military Aggression** - the term military servicemen are entrusted with the sacred tasks of teaching specialists to analyze problematic situations, such as the use of military force against the sovereignty, territorial integrity and independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan, to find a quick and fair solution; The idea of development of the homeland is a creative idea that combines the sense of belonging to the homeland, the interests of each person with the interests of the country, and encourages him to serve the people's happiness. As the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Supreme Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces Sh.M. Mirziyoyev noted, "Continuous work on educating our youth in the spirit of patriotism is of urgent importance for us. "Patriotism is the moral basis of the life of every state and is the most important mobilizing force for the comprehensive development of society." It is known that the Supreme Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, talking to the military personnel and listening to the reports of the officials, pointed out the serious and systemic problems that have accumulated in the field for many years and said, "These are personnel issues, providing the troops with modern weapons, social protection of the military personnel. are problems related to the education of young people and servicemen in the spirit of military patriotism.
