



**THE PATH FROM THE SERVICE OF GREAT PEOPLE TO A GREAT SCIENTIST, OR THE SERVICES OF THE MUFTI OF MOVAROUNNAHR MUSLIM RELIGIOUS OFFICE, SHEIKH MUKHTARJAN HAJI ABDULLAH, TO THE NATION AND RELIGION**

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**ABSTRACT**

"The path from the service of great people to a great scientist, or the services of Sheikh Mukhtarjan Haji Abdullah, mufti of the Movarounnahr Muslim religious office, to the nation and religion."

The article talks about the life path of Mukhtarjon Abdullayev, a child of the nation, who was loyal to his homeland and people, and who was a cure for the country's pain during complex political and social crises. The policy of that person in the issue of personnel in the religious office, his activities at international conferences and major events, his foreign trips and the work he carried out for the development of Uzbekistan and inter-ethnic friendship will be highlighted.

**INTRODUCTION**

Mukhtorjon Abdullayev (Mukhtorjon domla) was born in 1928 in the city of Kokan. When he was a child, his family moved to Bukhara. In 1936-1946, teacher Mukhtarjon studied at 6 high schools in Bukhara. Then he was accepted to study at the Mir Arab Madrasah. (1951). During his teenage years, Mukhtorjan was in the service of Haji Akbar Khan Muhitdinov, who was the head of the Mir Arab madrasa at that time (in 1946-1947), and managed to receive many of his blessings.

One day the boss asked him his purpose in life. After Mukhtarjan said that his biggest dream in life was to study at a madrasa, the headmaster Haji Akbar Khan turned to Moscow and made the young man enroll.

When he studied at the madrasa, he was distinguished by his thirst for knowledge, his wit, and his willingness to learn from his teachers.

During his studies at the madrasa, he memorized complex jurisprudential works such as "Kofiya", "Muhrasar ul Wiqaya" and received permission from his teachers. During this period, he also studied for a while at the "Baraqhan" madrasa, which is still working. There he became friends with famous scientists such as Minhojiddin Qori Abdullayev, Abuturob Yunusov, Uvais Aloutdinov.

In 1958, Mukhtarjon, who graduated from the madrasa with high marks, was hired by the madrasa management as a teacher. In 1961 - 1963, he studied at Damascus University in Syria.

After returning from abroad, Mukhtarjon was appointed the principal and head teacher of the Mir Arab madrasa, which was the only one in the Soviet Union at that time. He worked here in 1963-1965. He is a strict and demanding teacher to the students and teaches complex subjects such as sarf and nahw, Arabic phonetics and grammar.

In 1984-1988, teacher Mukhtarjon taught foreign students at the Tashkent Islamic Institute. Currently, students who studied under him are working in responsible positions in foreign countries.

In 1988-1991, he returned to the Mir Arab madrasa and worked there as a principal.

A unique teaching style, experience accumulated over the years, makes Mukhtarjon a favorite teacher for all pupils and students.

Mukhtarjon Abdullayev, in 1991-1993, served as an imam-khatib at the Hazrat Bahauddin Naqshband mosque in Bukhara. The teacher himself, as a representative of this order, carried out great creative works for the improvement of Hazrat Naqshband dargah.

In 1993-1997, Hazrat Mukhtarjon Haji was elected as the chairman of the religious office of Movarounnahr Muslims, and he fulfilled his duty to the people and the homeland with dignity.

After Mufti Hazrat retired from Muftiship in 1997 due to health problems, Hazrat Bahauddin, the great elder of Khajagon Naqshbandi Tariqah, became Imam Khatib in Naqshband Mosque and passed away on May 25, 2002.

Abdugofur Razzakov, a close student of the great teacher, will perform his funeral and he will be buried in the Hazrat Imam cemetery in Bukhara. May Allah be pleased with him.

On July 14, 1993, Mukhtarjon Abdullah held a general meeting of Imam Khatibs of the mosques of Tashkent city and Tashkent region at the headquarters of the Movarounnahr Muslim Religious Department. More than 250 people participated in it.

The following were considered.

1. Getting to know the new leaders of the Religious Administration.
2. Lecture of Mufti Mukhtarjon Abdullah Bukhari.
3. Letter of appeal in the name of Islam Karimov.
4. Election of Chief Imam of Tashkent city and Tashkent region.

Due to mufti's illness, consultant teacher Yusufkhan Shakir read the lecture.

After that, the chairman of the Religious Affairs Committee under the Cabinet of Ministers, Ustoz Abdugani Abdullah, spoke.

An appeal in the name of our honorable president was accepted.

Regarding the fourth issue, Rahmatullayev Abdurahman teacher to the city of Tashkent and Imam Khatib of the Hazrat Bilal mosque to the Tashkent region.

The Mufti introduced the new leadership of the Religious Board to the dear guests and told about their ongoing work and future plans. Until today, the contracts concluded between the World Islamic

Association and our office are in force, and the new management has stated that it intends to implement all the good works indicated in it as soon as possible.

During the conversation, Rahmatullah Inayatullah said that the World Islamic Association is ready for any help for the Muslims of our country.

The guests visited new mosques under construction in Tashkent. For example, they donated \$5,000 for the construction of the Imam Bukhari mosque in Sabir Rahimov district, \$3,000 for the activities of the Religious Administration, \$1,000 for the repair of the "Khoja Zudmurad" mosque in Samarkand, and \$1,000 for the repair of the Imam al-Bukhari mosque and madrasa.

In the summer of 1993, two Turkish businessmen, Mahmud Ekci and Muhsin Amin Effendi, went to a newly built mosque in the Yunusabad district of Tashkent city. Dr. Yusufkhan Shakir, case manager Abdukakhor Ghafarov, editor-in-chief Abdulaziz Mansur, imam-khatib of "Tilla Sheikh" mosque Abdurashid Qori Bahromov and other scholars took part in the ceremony here.

Dear guests, they donated 110,000 dollars for the new construction.

Dr. Yusufkhan Shakir, who has a deep understanding of the Islamic sciences and has rich experience in departmental and economic management, is the first deputy chairman of the Religious Department in order to organize the activities of the Religious Board and guide the religious staff. was appointed to the position.

Dr. Yusufkhan Shakir, the son of the first deputy chairman of the religious administration of Movarounnahr Muslims, Olimkhan Tora, was born in 1926 in the city of Tokmok, Kyrgyz Republic, in a religious family.

He received the basic religious information from his father Olimkhan Tora.

In 1948-1955, he studied at the Mir Arab madrasa in Bukhara. In 1955-1961, he graduated from the faculty of Arabic language at Al-Azhar University in Egypt. After that, from 1961 to 1975, he worked as the head of the International Department in the religious office, and from 1975 to 1990, he worked as a deputy mufti.

In 1975, they defended their candidate's thesis on the topic "Al-Azhar - the center of Arabic philology for 1000 years". Yusuf Khan Shakir, regardless of the position they work in the religious office, they have great merit in establishing friendship ties with religious people and religious organizations in foreign countries. who have been in the countries. Actively participated in all international conferences held in the Religious Department and scientific Islamic gatherings in foreign countries. Bukhara "Mir Arab" madrasa, Tashkent Islamic Institute, as well as teachers in other republics, Arabic literature, Qur'an They taught the subjects of tafsir, hadith, and puberty.

In September 1993, there was a great celebration in the old city of Bukhara. Because the 675-year wedding ceremony of the great scholar Khwaja Bahauddin Naqshband, who created the teachings of the Naqshbandi sect, which served for the purity of the Islamic religion, was celebrated here.

Many guests from all regions of Uzbekistan, countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States and abroad attended the conference, which is of great importance not only for the people of Bukhara, but also for the entire Muslim world. In particular, the participation of our country's president, Mr. Islam Karimov, increased the prestige of the conference.

On November 4, 1992, the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers in the presence of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On preparing and holding the 675th anniversary of the birth of Bahauddin Naqshband" was announced. It says: "The proposals of many citizens, scholars and the religious office

of Mowarounnahr Muslims to celebrate the 675th birthday of the great scientist Bahauddin Naqshband, who made a great contribution to the development of the thought of the peoples of the East in 1993."

According to this decision, the jubilee commission was formed under the chairmanship of the first deputy prime minister of the republic M. Q. Karaboyev. Many exemplary works have been carried out with the efforts of this commission. In particular, dozens of books about Alloma were published, scientific conferences were held, films were shot, exhibitions were organized, and special souvenirs were issued.

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
